Frequently Asked Questions:

- Q** – What is the Center Township Sanitary Authority versus the property owner’s responsibility if a backup occurs?
A – The Center Township Sanitary Authority maintains the sewer main line. The property owner is responsible for the lateral to where it connects to the main.
- Q** – How much are tap fees?
A – Tap fee per EDU is \$3,950. Please contact the Sanitary for Commercial property fees.
- Q** – Who is responsible for an unpaid sewer bill?
A – It is the responsibility of the property owner to pay unpaid sewer bills which include those in default by the tenant after the security deposit is applied.
- Q** – Does the Center Township Sanitary Authority file Municipal Liens?
A – The CTSA does file municipal liens. Liens can be placed on a property owing \$250 or more at anytime service in active. Balances left unpaid may lead to having a lien filed against the property associated with any outstanding account. The property owner will assume all costs which include filing the lien, interest, legal fees, penalties and lien satisfaction.
- Q** – How do I cancel service?
A – When moving, public water customers must contact the Center Township Municipal Water Authority to have a final meter reading done before the Sanitary Sewer Account can be finalized. Finalizing of the Sanitary Sewer Account will go back to the date in which the water reading is done. If a Sanitary Sewer only account, please contact the CTSA.
